45% are freshmen of whom 10% own a car, 20% are sophomores of whom 15% own a car and 35% are seniors of whom 5% own a car.

- i) Find the probability that a student in the college owns a car.
- ii) If a student does own a car, find the probability that the student is a senior.

- b) Two fair dice were rolled. What is the probability that the number showing on one will be twice the number appearing on the other?
